

Bowie StreetReach August 6-8, 2021

INFORMATION & COST BREAKDOWN

Welcome to StreetReach! Since 2008, Mount Oak Fellowship has sent teams out into local neighborhoods to do yard work for people who cannot do it for themselves. After a one-year hiatus, we are glad to return to reaching Bowie with the love of Jesus, one yard at a time. The outreach looks a little different this year – just one weekend, sleeping in your own bed, adding some local service projects for those who are not physically able to do yard work. We are excited to see how the Lord uses us this year!

Expected Schedule:

Friday, August 6

6:00 pm – 9:00 pm: Everyone will gather on Friday night to organize teams, get ready for Saturday and Sunday projects, and do some orientation, and team-building. Snacks and fun will be included, too!

Saturday, August 7

8:00 am: Meet at Mount Oak. After a devotion:

- Yard work teams will head out to local homes where we get to serve our neighbors by doing yard clean-up, small painting jobs, planting new flowers and shrubs, and even small home repairs.
- Another team will prepare gifts for past StreetReach homeowners (including putting small plants in pots and making greeting cards).
- Food Donation volunteers will go to their designated store.
- Kitchen team will prepare lunch.

Noon: Lunch, which will be delivered to each work site.

After lunch:

- Yard work continues.
- Another team will begin delivering gifts to past StreetReach homeowners.
- Kitchen team will clean up after lunch, set up dinner

Around 4:00 pm: Return to church.

5:00 pm: Breakfast for dinner!

6:00 pm: Clean-up, then fun activity

9:00 am: Combined Worship Service

10:15am: Time to serve:

- Yard work teams finish any remaining projects
- One team will deliver gifts to past StreetReach homeowners.
- Food Donation volunteers will go to their designated store.
- Sandwich team will make sandwiches for the homeless.
- One team will sort school supplies.
- Kitchen team will prepare lunch.

1:00 pm All return to church for lunch

After lunch: Clean up from all projects, including putting tools away and cleaning any borrowed vans.

ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

I hereby acknowledge and assume all of the risks of my child's participation in this Mount Oak Methodist Church Youth Activity, including by way of example and not limitation, any risks that may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them, or because of their possible liability without fault.

I certify that my child is physically fit and have not been advised to not participate by a qualified medical professional. I certify that there are no health-related reasons or problems which preclude my child's participation in this Youth Activity. I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form will be used by the organizers of the Youth Activity in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said Youth Activity.

In consideration of my application and permitting me to participate in this activity, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows:

(A) I WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE from any and all liability, including but not limited to, liability arising from the negligence or fault of the entities or persons released, for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, or actions of any kind which may hereafter occur to me including my traveling to and from this Youth Activity. THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: Mount Oak Methodist Church and/or their agents, representatives or volunteers.

(B) I INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE NOT TO SUE the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made as a result of participation in this Youth Activity, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.

I acknowledge that this Youth Activity may carry with it the potential for injury and personal loss. The risks may include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of participants, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, and lack of hydration.

I consent and agree that Mount Oak Methodist Church and/or their agents, representatives or volunteers may take photographs or digital recordings of me as a participant during this event and use these in any and all media for training or promotional purposes. I further consent that my identity may be revealed therein or by description text or commentary. I waive any rights, claims or interest and I understand that there will be no financial or other remuneration.

The accident waiver, release of liability and image release shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

I CERTIFY THAT I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, AND I FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENT. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT AND I SIGN IT ON MY OWN FREE WILL.

PARENT/GUARDIAN WAIVER FOR MINORS (under 18 years old)

The Undersigned parent and or natural guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity, has consented to his/her child or ward's participation in the Youth Activity, and has agreed individually and on behalf of the child or ward, to the terms of the accident waiver and release of liability set forth above. The undersigned parent or guardian further agrees to save and hold harmless and indemnify each and all parties referred to above from all liability, loss, cost, claim, or damage whatsoever which may be imposed upon said parties because of any defect on lack of such capacity to so act and release said parties on behalf of the minor and the parents or legal guardian.
